**DAYTON, OH -** The University at Buffalo women's basketball team struggled from the field on Friday afternoon as the Bulls shot just 27.6% against Dayton as the Flyers defeated the Bulls, 72-59. Buffalo falls to 6-2 on the season with the loss.

Buffalo got off to a tough start to the contest, as the Bulls were outscored 17-8 in the first quarter, but the Bulls were able to get back into the game in the second as a three-pointer from sophomore Hanna Hall pulled UB back within 19-17 with 5:47 left. The Bulls would tie the contest up at 21-21 on a Theresa Onwuka layup with 4:23 left and UB would go on to take their first lead of the afternoon following free throws from Cierra

<u>Dillard</u>. With Buffalo leading 27-26, the host Flyers went on an 8-0 run and took a 34-29 lead into the break.

Coming out of the break the teams traded blows in the third quarter as both sides were able to score 17 points each, as the Flyers took a 51-46 lead into the fourth quarter. Both teams went without a basket over the first two and a half minutes of the fourth and Buffalo was unable to score for nearly four minutes as an Onwuka layup pulled UB back within six.

Dayton took a double digit lead for the first time with 4:38 remaining and went on to lead by as many as 16 late in the quarter. A late bucket from Dillard pulled the Bulls within 13 and extended her streak of scoring 20 or more points in every game this season.

Dillard had 21 points, eight rebounds, and five assists, while Onwuka scored a career best 20 points on 9-of-17 shooting. She added eight rebounds as well.

Hall finished with six points and five boards, while <u>Adebola Adeyeye</u> and <u>Autumn Jones</u> each had five points.

Buffalo will now have an extended 11-day break from action to focus on finals before returning to the road on Tuesday Dec. 18 where they will complete their long road trip at Dartmouth.
